



Colorful and poetic, we enter a circus tent.








The tent is a continuous curved surface that envelops and generates


## space subspace

The canvas of the tent, materialized by a black-stained bendable wooden wave, surrounds the artist and the spectator. It seems to be held by copper ropes, which are connected to vertical elements.







The diva of the stage is the counter.



Under a starry alcove, the nail technicians are true manicure magicians.




# copper hallway

a threshold between different spaces.











a circle of representation.

















Victoria Baby Circus on Rue du Rempart Saint-Étienne takes us back to childhood, imagination and

magic.


